Australian Stock Horse Futurity, Maturity & Super Horse rules and regulations of entry

1. Any competitor or exhibitor may lodge a protest in writing to the secretary of the show committee within 30 minutes of the completion of an event. The protest must be accompanied by a fee, set by the organising committee, and is refundable if the protest is upheld. The protest shall be heard by the committee conducting the show and may be dealt with as such committee may direct. The show committee conducting the event will deal with problems involving questions arising at a show not specifically covered by the rules in this book.
2. A complaint concerning ASHS Accredited Judge/s may be forwarded to the Convenor of the Events Committee of the Society by an exhibitor, an agent, a rider, a handler, a trainer or a parent of a junior exhibitor (defined as a person who has not reached his 18th birthday) for any breach of the Judging Agreement. It must be In writing, signed by the protester, addressed to the Convenor of the Events Committee, received by the Society within seven (7) days of the alleged breach. A complaint must state the full name of the Judge, the subject of the complaint or charge and contain a complete and definitive statement of the acts, which constitute the alleged breach – precise details are necessary. The maker must be prepared to substantiate the protest or charge by personal testimony at a hearing or by sworn statements, witness or other evidence.
3. Futurity Sections (Youngstock, 2yo, 3yo, 4yo, Open) -All horses (except Youth riders under 13 years) must be registered with the ASHS and owned by current financial members. All riders must be current ASH financial members. Proof of membership and horse registration to be provided with nominations (photocopy of registration papers and membership for nominations to be accepted)
4. In all events, the horses age is at 31st July 2019
5. REGISTRATION PAPERS to be provided with nominations and presented on request for inspection.
6. Please refer to ASH Branding Policy.
7. If competing on more than one horse, please ensure you have enough handlers so we can keep the program running smoothly.
8. The Leichhardt Branch ASHS and the Australian Stock Horse Society shall not be responsible for any damage or injury occasioned to any exhibit or property of any exhibitor(s) from any cause whatsoever.
9. Snaffle bits only in futurities, maturity, open, youth and encouragement and ASHS dress required. Junior Hack and Senior Hack, ASH or English Attire acceptable.
10. Youth competitors under 18 years must wear a safety approved helmet (as per ASHS rules) with chin strap done up in all events and whilst riding anywhere on the grounds
11. The Leichhardt Branch Committee reserves the right to refuse any animal, if judged unfit or diseased, to take part in any way. Please refer to ASHS Horse Welfare Policy.
12. The organising committee reserve the right to alter the programme, judges or schedule.
13. The judges' decision is final subject to all other conditions being met.
14. STALLIONS and COLTS must be handled or ridden at all times by a person over 18 years. When being led or ridden they must have a bit in their mouth and when left unattended they must be suitable restrained (double tied or in portable panels).
15. This show will be conducted in accordance with the rules, regulations and bi-laws of the Australian Stock Horse Society. Competitors are advised it is their responsibility to read and abide by the ASH Rules.
16. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

17. The Leichhardt Branch ASHS reserves the right to combine, alter or delete classes with insufficient entries.
18. The score for hi-point is the aggregate for all sections.
19. Tie for hi-point will be either a ride off or a count back at the organizing committee's discretion, with a count back to be based on ridden sections.
20. In the event of 2 or more placing equal, prize money will be averaged and ribbons balloted.
21. Horses must compete in all phases to be eligible for hi-point awards.
22. Super Horse –cattle/campdraft section is conducted as per ASHS events handbook. A win will not change the competition status of a horse.
23. Encouragement Challenge – Open to ASH members and NON ASH Members (Day Membership will be required) who have not ever won or placed overall in any futurity, maturity, hack, open challenge, open breed challenge or have not won 2 or more encouragement challenges and have not won a high point encouragement challenge at any time (weanlings, yearlings futurities places not included). Riders may ride any age registered ASH horse and may compete in any other event. Please note only amateur riders are eligible to compete. Competitors may compete in any other events.
24. Junior and Senior Hack Challenge attire is optional, either ASH or English attire but horses must be ridden in a snaffle bit.
25. Riders can be changed provided the event has not commenced and that the rider has a good reason (eg: sickness/injury) and this substitution can only happen once per horse per event.
26. Horses can be substituted provided the event has not commenced and the substitute horse can be verified as ASH registered and the horse meets all the requirements of that event.
27. After nominations close, fees will only be refunded in exceptional circumstances, (vet certificate required)
28. Organising committees that deem a horse unfit for competition prior to the commencement of an event on the day may give a refund for that event
29. The Committee reserves the right to substitute products for prize money

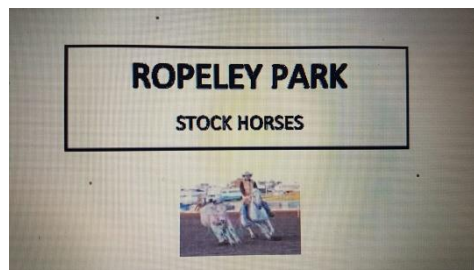

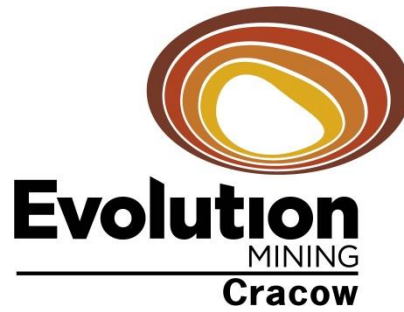
